Mr. Alvin Garrison presented the item of information; John G. Carlisle Elementary Comprehensive School Improvement Plan Report (Order No. 100815-01), 05.3 Community Use of School Facilities Review of Amended Procedures (Order No. 100815-02).

Ms. Joy Collins, Principal of John G. Carlisle Elementary, introduced the John G. Carlisle Elementary Comprehensive School Improvement Plan Report. Ms. Collins updated the Board on John G. Carlisle Elementary's work updating their mission and vision statements. John G. Carlisle is committed to meeting each child's academic, social and emotional needs through monitoring data and common assessments. Major efforts for continuous school improvement are: Professional Learning Communities work is more intentional this school year, focusing on the process of backward design. Teams deconstruct standards, creating common formative assessments, developing units and then analyzing student work through analysis sessions. Ms. Collins stated that John G. Carlisle continues to make steady progress toward academic and cultural goals. The staff are working collaboratively to ensure the success of all students through professional learning communities. The goal is always to create and sustain an environment where all students and staff feel valued and supported. Mr. Garrison thanked Ms. Collins and Ms. Sharon Craig, Assistant Principal for their professionalism and hard work.

Mr. Garrison introduced a Review of Procedure Amendments for 05.3 Community Use of Facilities. The Board reviewed the amendments and determined more discussion was needed before the final procedure and policy are in place.
