- e. Good News Report: Hybrid instruction resumes on Feb. 22. After school program resumes on the 22nd as well. There will be an in-person summer program this year. There won't be a budget cut for the FRYSC for next year.

2. Culture and Climate

- a. Enrollment Report: Council reviewed enrollment report. Current enrollment is 429.

3. Policy Update

- a. Assessment Policy: Council conducted first read of the Assessment Policy. Council recommended: clarify that this is a school level policy, clarify that this policy is in addition to the district protocol. Under Common Embedded Assessment Protocol subheading, clarify that assessments will be a combination of paper and electronic. Change CCSS to KAS. Update assessment delivery expectations to current expectations. Take out "slight prompting" in 2nd/3rd. Tweak 3P expectations K-2. Changes will be made based on council recommendations. Team Leads will take this policy to their teams for input.

- a. CSIP Goal 2: Council reviewed CSIP Goal 2. No recommendations were made.

5. Informational Items

- a. Reopening Information: Council was briefed on the reopening of school. The hybrid model of instruction will resume Monday, February 22. Half students will come M/T and the other half Th/F. CVA students will receive instruction on Wednesdays and during teacher planning on Mondays. All health and safety measures will be followed and strictly enforced: temperatures will be taken, hand-washing, mask wearing at all times, and social distancing. Lunch and will be staggered so there is only one grade level at a time. We have plenty of cleaning supplies on hand for classroom and building use.
- b. Instructional Assistant assignment while hybrid: We will be utilizing an instructional assistant, who was previously leading a special, to implement interventions for some struggling students (both hybrid and CVA). We currently have four specials, but 3 classes at most grade levels. IA will continue to teach specials during the time when a grade level has 4 classes.

6. Budget

- a. SBDM Budget: Council reviewed SBDM budget. There's a possibility that the district will no longer need to cut 25% of our budget due to the CARES funds.
