- e. Good News Report: Since coming back from Christmas break, participation seems to be up in live lessons and assignment completion. Admin is delivering prizes to Star Students- one student from each homeroom who has completed the most online work weekly. There was a decrease in percentage of intensive students on DIBELS at middle of the year benchmark. There was an increase in percentage on core students in 1st grade, which is where we typically see a decline because of the change to DORF. Teachers are getting more students into the building for small group work.
