2. Culture and Climate

- a. Enrollment Reports: Council reviewed report. Current enrollment is 430 students. This is about 25-30 students lower than where we typically are.
- b. Behavior Report: Council reviewed report. The report only covers two weeks where we were in person. Behavior incidents are very low because of the lack of in person days.
- c. CLC Report: Council reviewed report. 63 students are currently enrolled. ADA is 15 students. We generally try to keep enrollment at 100, but because of the pandemic we limited enrollment for social distancing purposes.
