# Student Support Purpose Statement and Roles

## Purpose:

To remove all barriers outside of the classroom to allow learning to take place inside the classroom.

## Roles of Support Staff:

- Review and take action on referrals submitted by school staff on a weekly basis.
- Enter and update information in the student tracker on actions/services provided by the support staff.
- Review radio calls and behavior data/referrals to check for trends on a student, teacher and school level.
- Review attendance of students.
- To provide inclusive support for students and staff (i.e. provide one point of contact for support).

## Student Support Members:

### COUNSELOR:

- Guide team through use of wrap around services.
- Maintains student tracker as a method of communicating with staff
- Serves as a liaison between mental health agencies and the school
- Supports Behavior RTI within the school setting
- Helps to develop and support Tier II and Tier III behavior plans
- Provides school based counseling/groups for our students

### BEHAVIOR COACH:

- Provides behavior support and coaching within the classroom which is proactive and targeted.
- Provides behavior support for students one-on-one to facilitate their return to the classroom
- Helps maintain Tier II behaviors charts and plans in the classroom
- Serves as a member of the Behavior RTI team.

### FAMILY RESOURCE COORDINATOR:

- Develops and maintains relationships with parents to increase parent involvement within the school
- Addresses the basic needs of our students and families to remove non-academic barriers
- Addresses attendance concerns on a student, district and family level

### SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST:

- Serves as a core member of the academic and behavior RTI
- Addresses academic concerns referred to the student support team
- Reviews data to facilitate the referral process to Tier II, Tier III and Specially Designed Instruction
- Serves as a liaison between mental health agencies and the school

## Student Support Members:



### CLC COORDINATOR:

- Coordinates afterschool programs daily from 3-6pm.
- Liaison between community organizations to enhance school and afterschool programs.
- Coordinates academic time after school and collaborates with teachers to meet the academic needs of students.

### SCHOOL NURSE:

- Meets the health needs of students (i.e. vision, hearing and medical needs)
- Collaborates with health agencies
- Schedules appointments for our students with the school based health center (Holmes Campus) and HealthPoint (Glenn O. Swing Campus)
