



Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What is the CLC?

A. The Wildcat Club Community Learning Center (CLC) at Glenn O. Swing Elementary primarily provides before and after school academic assistance opportunities for intermediate students (3rd-5th grade). In addition to this academic program, the CLC provides other opportunities (clubs, organizations, workshops, special events, etc.) for academic enrichment, youth development, and family and community engagement. The CLC acts as an extension of the school day. By partnering with several community partners (agencies, individuals, school staff, etc.), the Wildcat Club CLC at Glenn O. Swing Elementary is able to provide participating students with amazing opportunities outside of the normal school hours.

Q. Who may attend the CLC Program for Academic Assistance?

A. A limited number of spots is available for this program. The Glenn O. Swing leadership team selects 3rd – 5th Grade students based on academic need to participate in the program. If those students have K-2nd grade siblings interested in participating, siblings may be invited to participate on a case-by-case basis. Those students invited to participate in the program will be contacted by CLC Coordinator Elizabeth Mitchell, and will receive registration information.

Q. Who may attend other CLC opportunities, and what are those opportunities?

A. The CLC provides other after school opportunities outside of the Academic Assistance program. A large variety of clubs are offered, including but not limited to: Lego Robotics, Girls Who Game, Yearbook Club, and more. These clubs rotate seasonally and are only offered certain days of the week. Any student 3rd-5th grade is eligible to attend these extracurricular clubs, but spots are limited. Other opportunities like Family Events and Adult Skill-Building Events are open to all.

Q. What are the hours of the CLC during the 2021-2022 school year?

A. All of the clubs and activities of the CLC occur before or after school, and the hours are Monday-Friday each day from 7:15-7:55am and 3:05-5:30 p.m. Additionally, the CLC will host special evening and weekend events throughout the school year.

Q. Is there transportation to and from the CLC?

A. No. There is no bus service.

Q. What type of opportunities and activities are included in the CLC?

A. The CLC offers several club activities as well. Some clubs are available throughout the school year, while others may be offered only by quarter or semester. A large variety of clubs are offered, including but not limited to; Chess Club, Drama, Gardening, Glee Club, Violin Club, and more. Each student from 3rd -5th grade has their choice to participate in these clubs and activities. Please see a schedule (by quarter) for days and times of each available club.

Q. When is the CLC closed?

A. The CLC is open most days that school is in session. Additionally, if school is not in session (holidays, inclement weather, etc.), the CLC will not be operational.
