3. Mission and Vision Statement reviewed by Sean Bohannon
4. Good News
 - a. Covington Independent Schools improved overall score from 52.5 to 59.4. All schools met their annual measurable objective for the school year. [K-PREP]
 - b. Holmes Middle School improved their score from 49.8 to 55.0 (+5.2); 11th percentile to 20th percentile. Classification: Needs Improvement/Progressing School [K-PREP]
 - c. EXPLORE: improvement in Math and Science (and Composite); decreased achievement in English and Reading
 - d. 60 Day plan derived from Focus Visits; implemented 30 September 2014. Problems of Practice: Focus on Expectations for Learning and Achievement
 - e. Youth Services Center reports that 43% parents participate (teacher conferences, parent portal, parent nights, etc.)
 - f. Program Review – we received full points available for all content areas assessed through program review. The impact was an increase in overall assessment scores from 32 to 55.
5. Budget
 - a. Money allotted for Program Review: Art materials and supplies, band materials and supplies, Spanish books and materials, and Smart Boards
 - b. Priority Needs for Section 7 Funds: Instructional Assistants (4-5), Smart Boards (4), Laptops, Security Positions
