### **SBDM Council Policy**

#### **Selection and Implementation of Discipline and Classroom Management Techniques Required Policy**

In order to establish and maintain a safe and orderly school environment, the faculty and administration shall utilize and enforce the district Code of Student Conduct. In addition, faculty and administration shall work cooperatively to recommend to school council specific rules and practices designed to minimize disruption of the educational process and remove barriers to learning due to the behavior of students. The principal and faculty shall work cooperatively to amend these rules and practices for effectiveness annually and as the need arises during the school year. All school personnel are expected to enforce established rules and practices in an effort to create and maintain an efficient and effective learning environment. As such, an atmosphere of respect shall be established. This includes profanity, abusive language, defiance, threats or violent behavior. Order shall be expected. This includes disturbances, rowdy behavior, or disruptions anywhere on campus. High personal expectations shall be encouraged. This excludes habitual tardiness, truancy, neglectfulness in completing assignments and preparation.

Students involved in physical altercations or are proven to be the instigators of violent acts may be suspended for 10 days, may have a discipline hearing, may face disorderly conduct charges/arrest and may be recommended for expulsion.

Students that electronically threaten, bully, intimidate or harass others while at school, during schools hours or at a school event may be suspended for 10 days, may have a disciplinary hearing, may face disorderly conduct charges/arrest and may be recommended for expulsion.

The principal shall be responsible for administration and implementation of discipline within the school.
